



Volunteers make MINISTRY possible

There are many ways you can invest your time and talent to impact vulnerable women and men in the Quad Cities with biblically based, life – affirming services & education.

Complete PRC 101 Training and help in these amazing ways:

Volunteer team members must be 21 or older to serve in these positions.

One 4-hour shift weekly and occasional evening volunteer meetings are required.

- **Receptionist/Greeter:** These men and women team members answer the phone, welcome, and interact with clients and their guests, and assist with basic, routine office tasks.
- **Client Advocate:** After receptionist/greeter training, FEMALE Client Advocates are trained team members who serve in the center OR on the Mobile Medical Unit. These team members meet with clients/patients individually to assess needs and provide information.
- **Mobile Medical Unit Assistant:** After training as a receptionist and client advocate, these FEMALE team members assist the Staff Nurse on the Mobile Medical Unit on location throughout the Quad Cities area.
- **Bella's Boutique Attendant:** These team members get to extend Jesus' love by assisting moms & dads in selecting clothing & baby supplies and by ministering with a friendly smile, kind words and prayer when appropriate.
- **Dad Coaches & Teachers:** Godly MEN can come alongside new fathers as part of our Being a Father, Dr. Dad, and Fatherhood Coach classes & outreach. These classes are FOR MEN and taught exclusively BY MEN.
- **Class Teacher/Bible Study Leader:** These team members use specific, pre-selected materials to teach classes that cover staying healthy while pregnant, basic baby care, and becoming a proactive parent. Men's and Women's Bible Studies are taught with pre-selected materials.
- **Licensed, Certified Ultrasound Technician:** Use your professional skills to bless and minister. These team members administer ultrasounds in tandem with Staff Nurses.

These opportunities DO NOT require PRC 101 Training and time commitment varies:

- **Building Maintenance Helper:** Light "handyman" activities as needed.
- **Church Link Cheerleaders for Life:** Every local church needs **AT LEAST ONE!** This ministry "Cheerleader" works with their home church to promote Pregnancy Resources to their local congregation. This person informs the congregation of training opportunities and fundraising events and helps recruit participants for the Pregnancy Resources Walk for Life and often hosts a table at our annual Spring Banquet.
- **Cleaning Crew:** General cleaning of the centers. *This is a weekly time commitment; no meeting attendance required.*
- **Prayer Support Team:** These Prayer Warriors pray for the pressing needs of the ministry of Pregnancy Resources and our clients. You will receive a weekly email with current prayer requests and praises.
- **Occasional "Helps":** These ministry friends assist with intermittent basic clerical/office project needs and help with preparing for special events and ministry activities.

Volunteer Q&A

If I complete all three days of volunteer training, am I automatically a Center volunteer?

No. The training is an introduction, not a commitment. If you take the training and decide you want to volunteer, you will need to submit a volunteer application and be interviewed by the Executive Director to determine if there is a position for you here.

Should I take the training even if I'm not sure that I want to volunteer?

Yes! This three-day informational course will be offered in March, June, and October and will cover topics that include: honoring the value of life womb to tomb, bridging generational and cultural divides for more impactful communication and ministry, navigating trauma and grief, and ministering to a post abortive culture.
